1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of impugned order dated 08.04.2024 passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana in case bearing CIS No.NDPS-21874-2023 titled as "State Vs Gurmeet Kaur etc." whereby bail of the petitioner had been cancelled and her bonds were forfeited to the State and direction had been given for issuance of non bailable warrants.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that on 08.04.2024, she could not appear before the learned trial Court due to sickness. She had given intimation about the same to her counsel but he too did not appear before the concerned Court. Her absence was not intentional. She is ready to join the proceedings for appearing before the trial Court. It is urged that she may be ordered to be extended benefit of bail. Though no illegality or infirmity has been noticed in the impugned order, however, in view of the circumstances as explained in the petition and in the interest of

justice, one more opportunity is granted to the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court. As such, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court within a stipulated period and on his doing so, the learned trial Court shall admit her to bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
