Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to accept the file of the petitioner for registration of the new vehicle bearing Licence No. CH-01CU-0204 without any penalty charges.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents informs that a notification bearing No.2/7/210-H-III(7)-2024/12984 dated 16.08.2024 has been issued by the Administrator, UT Chandigarh, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (3) of Section 13 of the Punjab Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 1924 (Punjab Act No.4 of 1924) read with Clause (h) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 65 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, whereby the successful

bidders of the e-auction of the choice registration numbers concluded on 01.04.2024 have been exempted from payment of the penalty that had accrued w.e.f. 02.04.2024 till the date of issuance of notification.

In view of the aforesaid notification, learned counsel for the parties are *ad-idem* that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
