DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.249 dated
10.07.2023 registered under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of
IPC at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 05.02.2024, following order was passed:

*“Learned counsel for the respondent-complainant
concedes the fact that matter has since been compromised between the
parties. However, he submits that some of the terms of the
compromise are required to be complied with by the petitioner. He
also submits that he has no objection in case the petitioner is allowed
to join the investigation, and that in the meantime he may comply
with the terms of the compromise.*

Learned State counsel has no objection.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 14.03.2024 ”

Today learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Om Parkash submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 05.02.2024 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
