LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in the writ petition was for quashing communication dated 25.07.2007 (Annexure P-14), issued by Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana. There is a further prayer for directing respondent no.3 to prepare combined merit list of SC-A and SC-B candidates in terms of order dated 06.07.2006 passed by this Court.

2. Writ petition was dismissed on 10.12.2021 as petitioners not having secured requisite educational qualification from Kurukshetra University, present writ petition was not maintainable in view of decision of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in *Devender Bhaskar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others, 2022(1) SCT 51*. However, pursuant to order dated 03.07.2023 in the Review Petition(C) No.154 of 2022, passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, educational qualification secured from Kurukshetra University was treated to be valid and as per reply to application on behalf of respondent no.3, petitioners became eligible. It is further informed that certain writ petitions pertaining to selection of Art and Craft Teachers, pursuant to Advertisement No.6/2006 are still

pending.

3. Learned counsel for the State has argued that selection was carried out strictly in terms of Advertisement No.6/2006 dated 20.07.2006, wherein categories of SC-A and SC-B are duly provided. At this stage, no ground for interference is made out.

4. Be that as it may, the fact remains that writ petition was dismissed solely on the ground that petitioners were not eligible as they had secured their diploma in Art and Craft from Kurukshetra University. There was no consideration and adjudication on any other issue as raised, which necessarily would be within the realm of consideration by the Writ Court. Order dated 10.12.2021 is accordingly recalled and writ petition is restored to its original number. To be heard with CWP No.24123 of 2021.

5. Review application is accordingly disposed of.
