1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner should not be replaced with another Sewing Technology Instructor on the same terms and conditions, on which the petitioner is working.

2. As per learned counsel for the respondents, the services of the petitioner have already been terminated as there is no work existing for the post of Sewing Technology Instructor and no other person has been appointed in place of the petitioner on the same terms and conditions. Therefore, no grievance can be raised by the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the work of the post on which the petitioner was working still exists and, therefore, the

respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner in case she can be adjusted.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is given by the petitioner for her claim giving the details of her appointment, the same will be considered by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case the work for the post of the petitioner still exist and the same needs to be executed, due opportunity will be given to the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and will be duly conveyed to her.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. Pending miscl. application, if any, also stands disposed of.
