1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that the impugned order dated 16.01.2024 is appealable. However, he submits that in execution of the *ex parte* decree for an amount of Rs.51,90,390/- along with interest @ 9% per annum (from the due date till realization), the attached property of the petitioner is being put to sale. It is further submitted that as per notice of proclamation of sale, the auction is scheduled for 13.08.2024.
2. In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy of statutory appeal, in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
