The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No. 2 & 3 to activate/re-activate Aadhar Card of the petitioner which was deactivated on 05.02.2024 by Regional Office of UIDAI (Unique Identification Authority of India) and a further prayer to quash the notice dated 05.02.2024 issued by the respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted representation dated 12.07.2024 to the respondent No.3-Regional Officer of UIDAI, Chandigarh but no action has been taken by the said Department.

Mr. Dheeraj Jain, Senior Panel Counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents-Union of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.3-Regional Officer of UIDAI, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 12.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents-Union of India does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3-Regional Officer of UIDAI, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 12.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
