1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners intend to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the representation of the petitioners in a time bound manner so that the petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioners, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be



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mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation with the respondents.
