1. Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.381 dated 17.03.2020, registered under Sections 380/381/411 IPC, at Police Station Jagadhari City, District Yamunanagar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. In pursuance to the direction issued by this Court vide order dated 22.07.2024, learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari has sent his report dated 30.09.2024. It has been mentioned in the report that there were three accused persons against whom the present FIR was registered, however, present petition has been filed by one accused i.e. Arjun Kumar (petitioner) and no compromise has been effected by the complainant with non-petitioner/accused, who are not party before this Court.

3. Under these circumstances, it is clear that the compromise effected is a partial one. Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in CRM-M-48043-2023 titled as **Rakesh Das vs. State of Haryana and another,**

decided on 12.11.2024, has held that no quashing should be allowed on the basis of the partial compromise and thus, the present petition cannot be accepted and as such the same is disposed of with liberty to the parties to avail their remedy as per law.
