Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.191 dated 31.08.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Matter was sent to Mediation Centre. Compromise was effected. Petitioner was required to make certain payments as per the settlement effected at Mediation Centre. On the last date of hearing i.e. 14.02.2024, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner has failed to make compliance of the previous order dated 06.02.2024. Not even a single penny has been paid by the petitioner to the respondent as had been agreed by the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court in the Compromise/Settlement dated 05.12.2023.

In view of the afore-said circumstances, the protection of stay of arrest as granted vide order dated 02.11.2023 is hereby withdrawn.

As per request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, adjourned to 22.03.2024 for addressing arguments on merits.”

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Till date not even a single penny as per the settlement has been made as stated by learned counsel for the complainant. Considering the fact that neither the petitioner is making any payment nor there is any representation on his behalf, the circumstances indicates that petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed in default for want of prosecution.
