1. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner at the very outset submitted that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has already been promoted afresh but he should have been given his due promotion with retrospective effect. He further submitted that so far as the grant of date of promotion is concerned he may be permitted to file a representation to the respondents-HSVP and the present petition may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation if any, filed by the petitioner in accordance with law.

2. Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate, for respondents No.3 to 5 stated that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner stands promoted and he has no objection if the petitioner files any representation before the respondents-HSVP/competent authority, and in case any such representation is filed, the same shall be considered and decided within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the representation.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and prayer made by

learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of.

4. However, it is directed that in case the petitioner files any representation for seeking any earlier date of promotion then the same shall be considered by the respondents-HSVP/competent authority within a period of three months and strictly in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner or his counsel.

5. Since the main case has been disposed of, all the pending application(s) stand disposed of.
