HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks issuance of directions to official respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to register the criminal case against respondent Nos. 5 to 7, who allegedly took possession of two plots forcibly from the doner of the power of attorney to the petitioner.

[2] In the status report dated 17.08.2023 filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4, it is stated that an FIR No. 184 dated 23.06.2023, under Sections 406, 420 & 120-B of IPC and Section 82 of the Registration Act, stands registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, implicating the three accused persons, namely, (i) Roshan Lal; (ii) Jaswinder Kaur; and (iii) Manjit Singh.

However, learned State Counsel has not been able to point out as to why since the registration of FIR (supra), which is about ten months back, the investigation has not been concluded so far. He, on instructions

from the quarter concerned, submits that final report in case FIR (supra) shall be submitted before the CJM / Illaqa / Duty Magistrate concerned within a period of fifteen days from today.

[3] In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[4] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[5] It is made clear that in case the assurance extended to this Court is not complied with, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition with an advance copy of such application to the official respondents and in case by the time such application is listed, final report is not filed, the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, shall remain present in Court to explain the delay in conclusion of investigation as well as in filing of the final report.
