N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue directions to the official respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members, as the officials of the CIA staff are extending threats to them and were raiding the house of the petitioners without any reason.

2. On an advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and on instructions from HC Avtar Singh, stated that one FIR No.51 dated 10.07.2024 under Sections 308(5), 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and under Sections 27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar has been ordered to be registered against petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2 is not required in any criminal matter. Learned counsel for the State further

submits that no official from CIA staff or Police Station, Lohian will raid the

house of the petitioners without search warrants. He has further assured the Court that investigation in the present case shall be conducted fairly and impartially.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail their alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
4. The present petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
