MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.233 dated 08.05.2024 for the offences under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 452, 506, 509 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

2. On 23.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that in fact it is a case wherein the complainant party inflicted injury on the petitioner, although it was a blunt injury. While drawing the attention of this Court to the FIR, which has been annexed as Annexure P-1, it has been further argued that a perusal of the allegations levelled therein reveals that there is no specific attribution qua the petitioner except that he along with his family members inflicted an injury on the eye of injured Sushil Kumar and also fractured one of his fingers.”

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 23.07.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 23.07.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
