The prayer in the present petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of the FIR No.15 dated 10.03.2024 registered under Sections 22-C/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite various representations given to the Investigating Agency along with evidence in support of the innocence of the petitioner, no action has been taken by the Investigating Agency on the said representations. He, therefore prays that the present FIR be quashed.

I have heard the learned for the petitioner.

A perusal of the record would reveal that the report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has not yet been submitted. Therefore, the question of quashing of the FIR would not arise. Be that as it may, the Investigating Agency is directed to examine all the material provided by the petitioner including material finding part of this petition before
