The prayer in the petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 ‘BNSS’ is for the issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 to 5 to furnish the CCTV footage of the entry point of PS Canal Colony Bathinda and PS Thermal Bathinda to show the innocence of the petitioner.

A perusal of the petition would reveal that the petitioner is relying on the CCTV footages to establish his innocence. Preservation of the CCTV footage can be sought under Section 94 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 ‘BNSS’. Therefore, the instant petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his remedies in accordance with law including but not limited to the moving of an application under the same section seeking preservation of the CCTV footages.
