Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for passing an appropriate direction to respondents to make arrangements for the petitioners to meet their minor daughter, namely, Jashandeep Kaur D/o Baldev Singh, aged 17 years, living in care and custody of respondent No.3. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.3 to release the minor girl Jashandeep Kaur and handover her custody to the petitioners after getting the statement of the minor girl recorded.

The petitioners are present in person and minor daughter, namely, Jashandeep Kaur is also present in the Court.

This Court vide order dated 06.08.2024, had sent the minor daughter of the petitioners with them. Today, the Court has interacted with the minor daughter and parents i.e. the petitioners, separately. Minor daughter has brought to the notice of this Court that she is minor as on



date and would attain the age of majority by October, 2024 and she has desired that she be sent to the Aashiyana, Sector-15, Chandigarh only, as she is not ready to live with her parents. The parents have also fairly submitted before this Court that though they are doing their best to give their love and affection to their minor daughter, however, if she is not happy at home then she be sent as per her desire to the Aashiyana.

In view of the above, minor, namely, Jashandeep Kaur is directed to be taken to Aashiyana, Sector-15, Chandigarh today itself and would be retained there till she attains majority. However, the parties are at liberty to pursue their remedy in accordance with law, in case any further cause of action accrues to them.

Disposed of.
