1. The present petition has been filed challenging the order dated 07.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) by which the benefit of service rendered by the petitioner from the year 1988 to 30.09.2003 as a daily wage has not been taken into account as a qualifying service for the grant of benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner is covered by the judgment of this Court passed in CWP No. 7409 of 2021 titled as ***Virender Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 05.09.2023 and present petition be also disposed of in the same terms and conditions.



3. Learned counsel for the respondents has not been able to rebut the said contention that the claim of the petitioner for counting the part time service is entitled to be taken into account as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits.

4. Keeping in view the present petition is also disposed of in terms of the judgment of this Court passed in CWP No. 7409 of 2021 titled as ***Virender Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 05.09.2023.
