ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the respondent(s)-HSVP, on instructions, submits that land holding of the petitioner was acquired by the State Government for a public purpose. Thus, being an oustee, he is seeking allotment of a suitable site/plot as per his entitlement. It is urged that within four (4) weeks from today, the necessary advertisement to satisfy the claim of the oustees would be issued and the petitioner shall be at liberty to move the requisite application(s) in response thereto for allotment. In case, he is found eligible as per the eligibility criterion as laid down in the policy dated August 11, 2016, amended on May 8, 2018, his name would be included in draw of lots. And, if he succeeds, he would be allotted a suitable site/plot.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the petition be disposed of in terms of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent(s). However, in case, any dispute, cause of action or interest still survives, he be granted liberty to move an appropriate application for restoration of the petition and its decision on merits.

In the wake of the position sketched out above, and in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition is accordingly disposed of, binding them to the same.
