Learned counsel for the petitioner states that instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.34 dated 18.03.2018 as well as General Diary No.53 dated 21.03.2023 under Sections 323, 325, 148 and 149 (Section 325 IPC added later-on), in one case.
