1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to learned learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar to decide his application dated 09.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) in case titled as 'Jalandhar Sales Corporation Vs. M/s ABC, EZY Pack & others' bearing case No.NACT/2099/2017 dated 10.04.2017 whereby the petitioner had prayed for verification of the surety bonds, property and ID proof of surety and witnesses furnished on behalf of the private respondents/accused. The petitioner is also praying for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to decide the complaint dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-13) submitted by him against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the petitioner having approached the police for initiating action against the private respondents, the authorities concerned had been sitting over the matter. In support, he has drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure P-13 which is a complaint moved by the petitioner. It has been submitted that the official respondents were under a legal obligation to



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pass an appropriate order on his representation.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the complaint dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-13), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in ***Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. : 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.***
