On 23.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

On 31.07.2023, the following order was passed:-

“CRM-31220-2023

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed. Delay of 62 days in filing revision petition is condoned.

Main Case (O&M)

Inter alia contends that vide impugned order dated 21.02.2023, sentence of the petitioner was though suspended by learned Sessions Court/appellate court, but subject to deposit of 20% out of total compensation amount within two months. Under challenge before appellate court is a judgment dated 23.01.2023 passed by learned trial Court, whereby petitioner was convicted for 2 years under Section 138 of NI Act. Learned counsel submits that petitioner is a very poor person and the condition imposed is very harsh and same may result in rendering the appeal in-fructuous.

Notice of motion for 04.10.2023.

Meanwhile, as an interim measure, petitioner is directed deposit of 10% of total compensation under

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challenge. Subject thereto, he will be accorded the concession of bail by the learned appellate court.”

Thereafter, on 14.12.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Let fresh notice be issued to the respondent for 27.02.2024.

Dasti as well.

It is made clear that in case the process fee is not deposited immediately, the interim order dated 31.07.2023 shall stand vacated.”

Today, none appears on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 31.07.2023 stands vacated. In the interest of justice, adjourned to 23.08.2024.

In view of the above, as none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
