1. The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.0028 dated 19.05.2024 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudrian, District Kapurthala, and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at, between the parties.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 23.09.2024, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, Advocate puts in appearance and files her power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.3 to 5.

A request for granting another opportunity for getting the statements recorded has been made by learned counsel for the petitioners.



Though no ground is made out for another opportunity, however, purely in the interest of justice, one last opportunity is granted subject to payment of costs in the sum of ₹ 10,000/- which shall be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala.

The parties are directed to present themselves before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 21.10.2024 or any other date thereafter as may be convenient to the Court concerned, for getting their statements recorded in terms of order dated 23.07.2024 passed by this Court.

Adjourned to 21.11.2024.”

3. Report has been received from learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sultanpur Lodhi. As per report neither on 21.10.2024 nor on the subsequent date i.e. 08.11.2024 either of the parties appeared to get their statements recorded with respect to the compromise so arrived at between them. Further, there has also been non-compliance of order dated 23.09.2024 with respect to payment of Rs.10,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala.

4. In the circumstances, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
