The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0090, dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406/420 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

This Court vide order dated 23.07.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation and the petitioner was directed to bring a demand draft of Rs. 5,36,179/- in the name of his daughter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 23.07.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and in compliance to that order, demand draft bearing No.



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907790 of Rs. 5,36,179/- in the name of his daughter namely Nanki has been handed over to the complainant-Manu Bala.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Pratibha does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel for the complainant are *ad idem* that parties have resolved the matter amicably and in that endeavour will file petition for quashing on the basis of compromise entered into.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.07.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
