1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the criminal petition No. COMA/85/2021 dated 02.04.2021 under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners, pending trial before the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sonipat.
2. Mr. Ankit Chaudhary, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2 and filed his memo of appearance.
3. In view of the settled law pronounced by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Kunappareddy Vs. Kunappareddy Swarna Kumari (2016) 11 SCC 774*, Full Bench of Madras High Court in *Arul Daniel and others Vs. Suganya, 2022 SCC Online Mad 5435* and by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in *Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others Vs. State of Punjab and others* in *CRM-M-19553-2023* decided on 24.04.2023, the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 cannot be invoked to challenge proceedings emerging out of
