This is an application for placing on record Seniority List circulated by respondent No.2 vide memo dated 29.05.204 (Annexure A-1).

Keeping in view of the contents mentioned in the application, the same is taken allowed. Annexure A-1 is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CWP-27304 of 2016

In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that they are entitled for promotion to the post of Lecturer in Math retrospectively w.e.f the date the employee junior to them have been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are senior in the seniority list in the cadre of Masters, which has been

finalised now in May, 2024 and keeping in view the said fact, the petitioners become entitled for further promotion as Lecturer w.e.f the date employees junior to them have been promoted and also other consequential benefits including the further promotion to the post of Principal in case, any of the junior, who has been lower to the petitioners in the seniority list in the Master Cadre, has been promoted.

Learned State counsel submits the claim of the petitioners will be considered for promotion to the post of Lecturer keeping in view the seniority list issued in the Cadre of Masters in May, 2024 and in case, it is found that any employee who is junior to the petitioners in the Master Cadre has been promoted as a Lecturer in preference to the petitioners, the claim of the petitioners will also be considered for promotion in the Lecturer Cadre w.e.f. the date any employee junior to the petitioners have been promoted and in case, it is found feasible to grant relief to the petitioners, the same be granted otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order as to why, the claim of the petitioners for promotion cannot be accepted, which reasons will also be conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
