1. The present petition has been filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for having committed the grave act and wilfully violating the directions dated 15.04.2024 and 24.04.2024, issued by this Court in CRM M 18028-2024 titled as ‘Pardeep Kumar and others vs State of Haryana and others’.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana and Mr. Harkesh Kumar, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied with, vide order dated 13.07.2024, passed by the respondent and no further action is required to be taken in the matter. The Registry is directed to tag the aforesaid order on the file after scanning at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
6. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
