SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been preferred with the following substantial prayer:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that petition may kindly be accepted and impugned order dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) regarding issuance of Look Out Circular issued by respondent No.2, impugned Order dated 01.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) regarding issuance of Look Out Circular issued by respondent No.1 and impugned Order dated 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) regarding impounded of passport bearing No.P8075722 issued by respondent No.4 in case FIR No.478 dated 26.11.2017 under Sections 498- A, 506, 406, 34, 377 of IPC registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise dated 27.11.2020 (Annexure P-6) between the father of the petitioner and respondent No.5/Complainant through their power of Attorney may kindly be quashed, in the interest of justice.”

2. Vide order of even date i.e. 18.04.2024 passed in CRM-M-40293-2020; the FIR in question i.e. FIR No.478 dated 26.11.2017, registered under Section 498-A, 506, 406, 34 and 377 IPC at Police Station

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra has been quashed on the basis of compromise between the parties.

3. Keeping in view the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case especially the factum of the matter having been settled between the parties & the matter arising out of a matrimonial dispute, it would be pragmatic to allow the present petition and quash the impugned orders dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P-3), 01.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) and 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-5). Further; Regional Officer, Passport Office, Chandigarh-respondent No.4 is directed to release the passport of the petitioner within 15 days from receipt/production of the certified copy of this order.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
