1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 0184 dated 10.07.2020 registered under Sections 363/366 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise dated 06.11.2020 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 15.04.2024:-

“Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR bearing No.0184 dated 10.07.2020 registered under Sections 363, 366 IPC at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks another opportunity to record the statement of respondent No.3, as she could not appear before the



learned jurisdictional Magistrate for recording her statement in support of the compromise due to unavoidable circumstances.

In view of the above, respondent No.3 is granted one more opportunity to depose in favour of the compromise by appearing before the jurisdictional/Illaq Magistrate in terms of order dated 12.11.2020 subject to the costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patients Welfare Funds. PGIMER, Chandigarh for wasting precious time of the Court.

Adjourned to 17.05.2024.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834 and Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63 and Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 0184 dated 10.07.2020 registered under Sections 363/366 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar City (Annexure P-1) and compromise dated 06.11.2020, all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioner.
