1. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the petitioners have been granted the benefit of equivalence of pay scale of Rs.1800-3200 w.e.f. 1991 aligned with the pay scale of Agriculture Development Officer/Agriculture Sub-Inspector working with the Soil Conservation and Engineering Department, State of Punjab.

It has also been contended that the pay of the petitioners has been refixed along with revision of pension and gratuity, however, the arrears of pay as well as the revised benefit towards leave encashment have not been granted.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits

that in case the petitioners submit a detailed representation within a period of two weeks from today regarding their unsatisfied claim, the same shall be considered and dealt with upon granting of an opportunity of hearing to them, within a period of 04 weeks and speaking order thereupon shall be conveyed to the petitioners, within a week thereafter.

3. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the parties, the present petition is disposed of. Both the parties shall be bound by their respective statements. Rule stands discharged.
