1. Through the instant appeal, the appellant throws challenge to the order dated 04.03.2021, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, vide which the regular bail application of the appellant in case FIR No.50, dated 22.01.2017, under Sections 365 and 392 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad, has been dismissed.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 11.03.2024, this Court had called for a report from the learned trial Court concerned regarding the time required to conclude the trial.

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, the learned trial Court concerned has sent a report to this Court vide letter No.397, dated 21.03.2024, and as per the report, it will take another two or three months to conclude the trial.

4. In view of the specific report of the trial Court concerned, the instant petition is ordered to be **dismissed**, at this stage, with liberty to the appellant to re-access this Court in case there is further inordinate delay in conclusion of the trial.
