Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents No.1 to 5 to take stern action on the representation of the petitioners dated 19.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) and to issue directions to respondent No.6-Gram Panchayat to throw and bury animal carcass at its allotted proper place(which has been shown in Jamabandi for the year 2020-2021 instead of throwing and burying it near the residential houses of the petitioners and other persons, so that Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) may not spread in human being in residential area.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievance, petitioners have filed representation dated 19.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Barnala but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondent till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Mr. Suvir Sidhu, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Barnala is directed to decide the representation dated 19.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
