The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.276 dated 19.09.2023 under Sections 120-B, 34, 419 and 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Sector 9-A District Gurugram and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 06.07.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2 . This Court vide order dated 24.07.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Civil Judge (JD/JMIC), Gurugram and got their statements recorded.

On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 04.09.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Today draft of sum of Rs.6,00,000/- has been given by learned counsel for the petitioner to learned counsel for respondent no.2. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 submits that he has no objection if the petition is allowed and FIR as lodged against the petitioners stands quashed.

5. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

7. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.276 dated 19.09.2023 under Sections 120-B, 34, 419 and 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Sector 9-A District Gurugram and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 06.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
