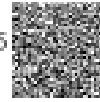

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was entitled for the grant of one additional increment on promotion from the post of Assistant Professor Stage-I to II, Assistant Professor, Stage-II to III and further from Assistant Professor Stage-III to Associate Professor, which benefit was not granted to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the similar relief has already been granted to another employee namely, Dr. Khushdeep Goyal vide order dated 12.06.2020 (Annexure P/11) and hence, the petitioner should also be granted the said benefit as being granted to said employee.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance by way of submitting representations,

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which have been appended with the present petitions as Annexure P/6 to P/9 and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide her latest representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P/9).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sanjeev Roy, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P/9) has been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
