1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the letter dated 05.12.2023, Annexure P-5.
2. Learned counsel submits that there was an emergency certificate dated 02.09.2023, Annexure P-1, for admission that was issued by the hospital concerned and discharge summary dated 17.06.2023, Annexure P-2, also showing that the wife of the petitioner was unable to walk and get up from sitting position and in pain for two months, these aspects he wishes to bring the notice of the authorities for which a detailed representation will be submitted, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

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3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner shall submit representation within a period of four weeks, the same shall be decided expeditiously preferably in 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him, and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress.
