This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 25.05.2023 passed in CWP-11484-2023.

Affidavit of Ashok Kumar Meena, IAS, Director, State Transport, Haryana, Chandigarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 25.05.2023 passed in CWP-11484-2023 has been complied with and the department after considering the choices submitted by the petitioner and other aggrieved employees, has passed the order dated 22.11.2023 (Annexure R-3).

Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
