1. The dispute in these two revision petitions is with regard to correctness of the assessment of the amount of maintenance *pendente lite* payable to the child who is staying with the wife. The Family Court has directed that the wife will contribute Rs.10,000/-, whereas, the husband will contribute Rs.30,000/- per month. Both, husband and the wife are highly qualified doctors. The husband is MD (Anesthesia) and the wife is M.D. (Gynecology). Both are working in the private sector. As per the affidavit of the husband, his monthly income is Rs.1,35,000/- per month. On the other

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the stage of leading evidence. The Family Court has made sure that there is corpus of Rs.40,000/- per month for maintenance of child, particularly when he studying in a school with monthly fee of Rs.7,000/- apart from the transportation charges.

- 2.Keeping in view aforesaid facts, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere with the order passed by the Family Court. However, it is desired that the Family Court will make sincere endeavors for expeditious disposal of the divorce petition.
