Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 66 dated 17.04.2022 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code (Section 302 and 120-B of IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of passing of 01 year and 08 months, trial of the case has not commenced till date and even the charges have not been framed.

Faced with the same, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surender Singh submits that endeavour shall be made to conclude the examination of the prosecution witnesses within a period of 03 months from the date of framing of charges by the trial Court.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Thus, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. Learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
