GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioners-Jagtar Singh @ Judi has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.359 dated 16.09.2020, Police Station Pundri District Kaithal, under Sections 406, 420, 370, 384 and 506 IPC, and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 07.11.2023, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned District and Sessions Judge, Kaithal, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statement of

petitioners/accused Jagtar Singh @ Judi and complainant/injured Kanwar Pal and Vishal have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

- 4. The complainant/injured Kanwar Pal and Vishal in their statement had stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
- 5. The learned District and Sessions Judge, Kaithal, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
- 6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.359 dated 16.09.2020, Police Station Pundri District Kaithal, under Sections 406, 420, 370, 384 and 506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
