1. In pursuance of last order, reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Deepak Kundu, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Bhiwani, has been filed on behalf of the respondents in Court today, which is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that except the arrears of salary for the contractual period, all other benefits stand released in favour of the petitioner and the remaining benefits shall be released within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
