1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.12.2022 passed in CWP-30128-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Kamal Kishore Yadav, Principal Secretary, Govt. of Punjab, Department of Higher Education, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 23.12.2022 passed in CWP-30128-2022 has been complied with and speaking order dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
