Prayer in the present petition is for grant of compensation on account of death of Som Pal due to electrocution.

As per the reply filed on behalf of the respondents, the electrocution did not take on account of any public distribution system installed by the respondents-Distribution Licensee and the electrocution current was within the board installed by the shop owner himself. Specific assertions in this regard have been raised in paragraphs No.4 to 6 of the preliminary submissions of the reply filed on behalf of the respondents.

Since disputed questions of facts as regards the nature of the incident and the manner in which the electrocution took place arise, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the present petition so as to take recourse to his alternate remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberty as aforesaid.
