The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S for quashing of the complaints bearing No. 13332/CP/2024/DGP dated 26.06.2024 (Annexure P-10), complaint bearing No. 4436-P dated 04.07.2024, 2019-CAS (Annexure P-15), complaint No.4180-2 dated 26.06.2024 (Annexure P-18), complaint No.478-CAS dated 03.07.2024 (Annexure P-21) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
2. On advance notice, Ms. Sheenu Sura, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared and submits that the enquiries in all the aforestated complaints were ordered to be clubbed and thereafter, one FIR No.471 dated 23.07.2024, under Sections 420,467,468,471 and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurugram has been ordered to be registered against the petitioners and other co-accused. She has further assured the Court that the

investigation in the abovementioned FIR shall be conducted fairly and impartially. She further submits that since the aforstated complaints have culminated into FIR, the petitioners shall not be called in the enquiries, in connection with any of the above complaints and shall be associated only during the process of investigation in case FIR No.471 dated 23.07.2024, registered under Sections 420,467,468,471 and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurugram.

- 3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed of.
- 4. Needless to observe that the petitioners shall be at liberty to avail their alternative remedies, in accordance with law.
- 5. In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of.
