1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for wilful disobedience of order dated 30.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP 24545 of 2015 titled as ‘*Sanjeev Kumar vs State of Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited of Punjab and another*’.
2. Counsel for the respondent, while placing reliance on order dated 01.07.2024, passed by the Under Secretary, HVPNL, Panchkula submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied with and the representation of the petitioner has been rejected. The Registry is directed to tag the aforesaid order with the file after scanning the same at an appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
4. However, if the petitioner is having any grievance, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law,
