The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

2. Vide order dated 24.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 12.10.2024 and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 25.09.2024. His further custodial interrogation is not required. In view of this submission, this Court of the opinion that no purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the order dated 24.07.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to compliance of usual terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
