1. The present petition has been filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 12 and 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 31.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP 1986-2024 titled as ‘Laxmi Narayan Vs. State of Haryana and others’.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana and Mr. Harkesh Kumar, AAG, Haryana, accept notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied with, vide order dated 24.07.2024, passed by the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Rohtak and no further action is required to be taken in the matter. The Registry is directed to tag the aforesaid order on the file after scanning at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
6. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
