The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.221 dated 22.06.2024 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.07.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 28.08.2024 by way of an affidavit of Ravisher Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Khadur Sahib has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the

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aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.07.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
