MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

This judgment shall dispose off aforementioned four writ
petitions as common questions of facts and law are involved therein.



2. Following prayer(s) have been made in the above writ petitions.
- a)** CWP-17254-2024 has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the impugned action of the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula whereby petitioners have been declared not qualified in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) for the post of Male Constable (GD) vide Advertisement No. 6/2024 dated 28.06.2024 Category No.1 (P-2).
- b)** CWP-19704-2024 has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the impugned action of the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula whereby petitioners have been declared not qualified in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) for the post of Male Constable (GD) and Female Constable (GD) vide Advertisement No. 6/2024 dated 28.06.2024 Category Nos.1 and 2 (P-2).
- c)** CWP No. 18526 of 2024 has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the impugned action of the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula whereby petitioners have been declared not qualified in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) for the post of Male Constable (GD) and Female Constable (GD) vide Advertisement No. 6/2024 dated 28.06.2024 Category Nos.1 and 2 (P-2).
- d)** CWP No. 20058 of 2024 has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, for issuance of a writ in the nature of



Certiorari for quashing the impugned action of the respondent- Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula whereby petitioners have been declared not qualified in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) for the post of Male Constable (GD) and Female Constable (GD) vide Advertisement No. 6/2024 dated 28.06.2024 Category Nos.1 and 2 (P-2).

3. In pursuance of order dated 08.11.2024 passed by this Court, result of the petitioners have been produced in a sealed cover which has been opened, perused and returned to the official concerned.

4. Learned State counsel has also produced communication dated 12.11.2024 received from Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, which is taken on record and marked as 'X'. Copy supplied to the other side.

5. For reference, relevant portion of the aforesaid communication is reproduced as under:-

“Further it is also pertinent to mention here that the Hon'ble court had provisionally allowed the petitioner to participate in the further selection process by considering the petitioner as eligible in view of Height and chest. The Commission has allowed the petitioners for further selection process in furtherance of the stand of State. The Commission had conduct the PMT, Physical Screening Test and the candidate who had qualified the PMT, PST and short listing the Written Exam, were also allowed to appear in written exam and the result of these candidates not declared yet due to specific directions of the court to not declare the result of the petitioners.

Further is pursuance to above mentioned stand of the government, the Commission published the notice dated



the height relaxation to the EWS candidates.

That the case was listed on 08.11.2024 and the Court ordered to produce the result of the petitioners in sealed cover on 13.11.2024 and the same was produced. It is submitted that the Commission has already given relaxation in furtherance of the stand of the Government. The result of the candidates who was not petitioner was declared and the result of these candidates not declared yet due to specific directions of this Hon'ble Court.

It is submitted that the Commission is ready to declare the result of the petitioners and recommend the petitioners whosoever come into the selection zone after taking relaxation, subject to other conditions and stages of the selection process, with the permission of this Hon'ble court.”

6. In view of the above development, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that all the writ petitions be disposed off as not pressed at this stage.
7. Ordered accordingly.
8. Needless to say that necessary exercise for declaration of the result of all the petitioners be carried out by the Commission expeditiously and further steps for selection/appointment of successful petitioners be taken in accordance with law, while treating them at par with other candidates, but as per merit in terms of the Advt. No. 6/2024.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
