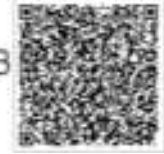

1 Grievance raised in this writ petition by petitioner who was appointed on contract basis with respondent no.2, is that Child Care Leave was not granted to her. Prayer is for quashing Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972, specially Rule 43-C thereof to the extent that a contractual employee is not granted Child Care Leave as provided to regular employees.

2 Learned counsel for respondent No.2 informs that the petitioner is no longer in service with the respondent-institute since January 2023.



3 Perusal of file reveals that none has been appearing on behalf of the petitioner since September 2022. Today, again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

4 Writ petition is accordingly dismissed in default/for non-prosecution.
