Prayer in the instant application is for advancing the date of hearing of main case from 22.08.2024 to some early date.

Heard.

In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the date of hearing of the main case is advanced from 22.08.2024 to today itself.

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1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 05.06.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Trial Court, whereby non-bailable warrants were issued against him in case CHI/269/2021 in FIR No.123 dated 29.04.2020 under Sections 509, 201 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa.



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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the learned Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the learned Trial Court, and directions be given to the learned Trial Court that his application of bail, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioners to appear and surrender before the learned Trial Court on 14.08.2024. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. However, this shall be subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority concerned, which shall be a condition precedent. The petitioner is also directed to plant 02 indigenous fruit bearing trees and 02 shady trees each within the judicial complex in Mansa, with the specific area to be identified by the District Legal Services Authority concerned on 14.08.2024; the DLSA would also ensure the proper maintenance and upkeep of the trees so planted.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the learned Trial Court on 14.08.2024 and to comply with the above said directions, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter.

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In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the learned Trial Court shall decide it in accordance with law.
